## GENERAL

BELTS	Plain black leather belt with trousers
HAIR	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Hair needs to be off the collar and out of the eyes</li><li>• Clean shaven</li><li>• No extreme hair styles</li></ul>
JEWELLERY	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• No visible tattoos</li><li>• No more than one small plain silver or gold stud each ear</li><li>• No facial piercings or stretchers</li><li>• No necklaces, rings or bracelets</li></ul>
MAKEUP	No makeup
SHOES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Black traditional leather lace-up school shoes</li><li>• No flat sole shoes</li></ul>
SOCKS/ STOCKINGS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Black ankle socks <u>or</u> stockings with skirts</li><li>• Long, stripe school socks with shorts</li><li>• Black dress socks with trousers</li></ul>

## UNIFORM REQUIREMENTS

CAPS/SCARVES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• School cap only</li><li>• School scarf only</li></ul>
JACKET	School uniform jacket only - to be worn at school, to and from school
JERSEY	School jersey only
SHIRTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Years 9 - 12 - Black uniform polo only</li><li>• Year 13 - White blouse, white uniform shirt and tie, or black uniform polo</li></ul>
SHORTS	School shorts only
SKIRT	School skirt only
TROUSERS	School trousers only
