

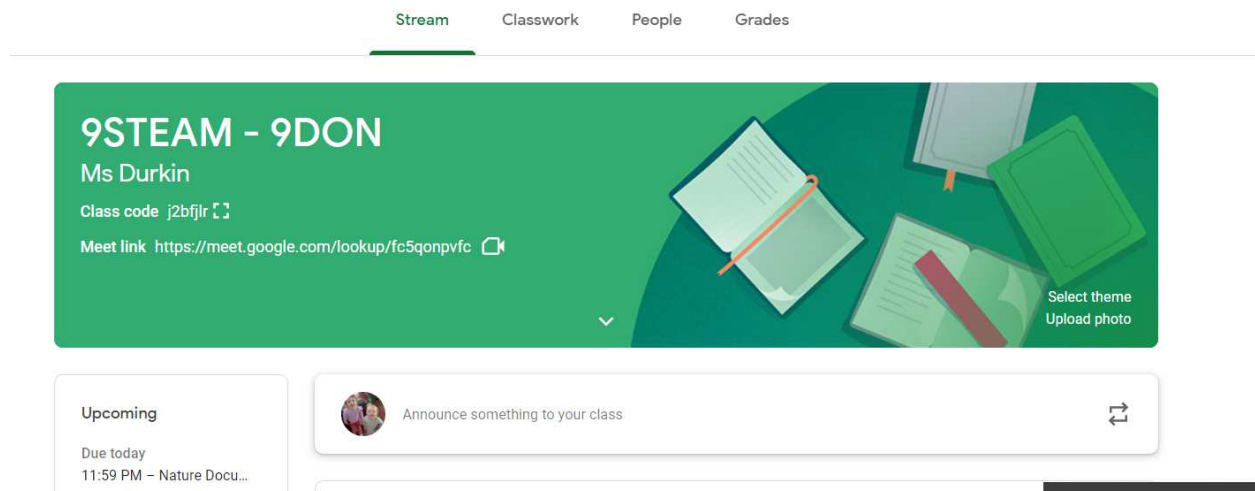

Information for Whānau

Google Classroom

Google Classroom will continue to be the platform for ākonga(students) to access their mahi (set work and instructions).

All lessons, Google Meets and screencastify links will be posted on Google Classroom.



Junior Students:

- There will be one Google Meet or Screencastify per class per week plus one optional tutorial. Tutorials will run at 3.15pm for students to ask questions about their work. Both Google Meets and tutorials will be scheduled through Google Classroom.
- Teachers will also provide information through Google Classroom posts, including information on extension tasks.
- Year 9 students will be offered an optional enrichment project for their option subject. Information on this will be provided through Google Classroom.

Senior Students:

- There will be two Google Meets per week: The First Google Meet at the start of week will be to go over the posted work and the second Google Meet will be for review and questions.
- Some teachers may schedule one Google Meet plus provide one Screencastify per week. The Screencastify will allow students to review at a later time.
