


A YEAR TO REMEMBER

Ehara taku toa i te toa takitahi, engari, he toa takitini! Success is not the work of one, but the work of many!





EPRO8



Our junior engineers put their collaboration, creativity and construction skills to the test at the EPro8 Challenge in July.

The annual event is an engineering and problem solving competition in the form of a race. The aim is to solve the most engineering tasks in a three hour time frame.

The competition gives creative and practical students a chance to shine in an exciting, competitive environment and is a highlight for our STEM enthusiasts.

LEVEL 2 BIOLOGY

The rainforest became the classroom as our Level 2 biologists ventured into the beautiful Waitākere Ranges to observe the forest ecology of Arataki.

Students looked at the community pattern of stratification and how abiotic factors such as light, humidity and temperature influenced life in each strata layer. They also observed the unique adaptations and relationships that exist in this forest community and spotted a number of interesting features, such as the Nikau relying on the Kereru for seed dispersal, the Northern Rata growing over the Rimu and competing for resources, and large Kauri trees with all of their perching lilies growing up high to reach the light.

A huge thank you to the Park Rangers of Arataki for a full day of learning amongst nature and to our Science team for providing such an enriching learning experience.









INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

Our International Students had the ultimate kiwi experience as they got up close and personal with our native fauna on their visit to Waitomo. They explored the fascinating limestone formations in and around the caves and saw the glow worms illuminating the chambers above. Next stop on the trip was the Ōtorohanga Kiwi House, arriving just in time to see them feeding and to learn all about their life cycle, conservation and breeding programme.

This was a great opportunity to see Kiwi up close, and many other native bird species including; Wood Pigeons, Weka, Rail, Kākā, Bellbird and Tui and long finned eels being hand fed.

Thank you to Mrs Hart for taking our students on an educationally rewarding trip to one of the timeless treasures of Aotearoa, 30 million years in the making!



WOMEN IN ENGINEERING

We had the pleasure of welcoming back former Dux Caroline Dumogho in August when we hosted the Women in Engineering Group (WEN) who spoke to Year 11, 12 and 13 students interested in pursuing a career in Engineering.

Students had the opportunity to test their Electronics knowledge using 'Breadboards' to create parallel and series circuits to control fans and buzzers. They were also given an insight into what Engineering is like at the University of Auckland.

Thank you to Ms Durkin and our Maths Department for their continued encouragement and support of our exceptional mathletes!




ROTARY SCIENCE FORUM
